Perfect for drinking immediately, enjoy chilled on a warm summer's day.

The 2015 growing season was characterised by a dry spring and summer. Lower yields due to cooler weather during flowering have produced wonderful fruit intensity.

The Pinot Gris grapes for this wine were sourced from two vineyards in the Blind River sub-region of the Awatere Valley – the Home Block and neighbouring McKee vineyard. The Pinot Noir grapes were sourced from the well-tended, low yielding vineyards of the Home Block in Blind River as well as two vineyards in the Wairau Valleys.
