

Tinpot Hut 2016 Marlborough Pinot Noir

WINFMAKER Fiona Turner COLOUR Ruby red with a purple hue AROMA Intense aromas of black cherry, blackberry and plum mingle with a hint of redcurrant. Sayoury mushroom and toasty oak characters complete the attractive nose. PALATE Classic black cherry notes dominate the palate and are supported by hints of bramble, reflecting the aromatics. Structurally the tannins are soft and silky and well balanced acidity ensures good length and weight. CELLARING AND Perfect for drinking after release, this Pinot Noir will be at its best FOOD PAIRING over the next 3 to 4 years. Match with lamb, duck and venison dishes, and firm cheeses. NDOT I The 2016 growing season was characterised by a dry spring and VINTAGE summer, with higher than average temperatures. Shoot thinning, bunch removal, & green thinning were used to bring the vines and vields into balance, producing fruit of exceptional character and i ntensity. VINIFICATION Sourced from two well-tended, low yielding vineyards in the Blind River/Omaka Valley sub-regions, the fruit was picked at optimum ripeness and carefully transported to the winery for de-stemming and chilling. Each vineyard was kept separate in small open top fermenters and cold-soaked to extract maximum flavor and colour stability. 5% whole clusters were retained in the ferment to add phenolic stability and to enhance mouth feel and complexity. The wine was fermented using a mixture of selected yeast strains and hand plunged up to 6 times daily. After fermentation several batches were put to French oak barrels. The remaining batches were aged in stainless steel tanks to preserve TINPOT HUT the delicate fruit characters. Each batch went through malolactic 2016 MARLBOROUGH fermentation and was aged on lees before being blended. DINOT NOI stabilised, lightly egg white fined and prepared for bottling.
